

Junior Golfers Etiquette Guide

Restrictions

Child Age 8-12:

- Must always be accompanied by an adult or Junior Member
- No Tee Times before 5pm Mon-Fri
- No Tee Times before 2pm on Weekends & Holidays

Junior Age 13-18:

- No Tee Times between 2pm-5pm Mon-Friday
- No Tee Times before 2pm on Weekends & Holidays unless accompanied by an adult member.

Golf Etiquette:

Dress Code

Please adhere to the club's dress code policy to maintain a professional and respectful appearance on the course.

Respect the Course

Treat the golf course with care and respect. Avoid unnecessary damage to the turf by repairing divots and ball marks on the greens. Keep golf carts on designated paths and refrain from driving near greens or bunkers.

Punctuality

Arrive at the course on time and be ready to play when it's your turn. This shows respect for other golfers and helps maintain the pace of play. Remember to practice "ready golf" to keep the game flowing smoothly.

Honesty

Always play by the rules and keep an accurate score. Honesty is an integral part of golf, and it's important to maintain the integrity of the game.

Safety

Prioritize safety on the course. Be aware of other golfers and never hit your ball if someone is within your range. Shout "fore" if your ball is heading towards other players to warn them.

Be Quiet

Avoid unnecessary noise and distractions during play. Be respectful of other players by keeping conversations low and refraining from using electronic devices.

Pace of Play

Play at a reasonable pace to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience for all golfers. Be efficient in your preparation for shots and be ready to play when it's your turn. If you fall behind, kindly allow faster groups to play through.

Raking Bunkers

After hitting a shot from a bunker, please take the time to carefully rake the sand to remove footprints and damage, leaving it in good condition for the next golfer.

Replacing Divots

If you take a divot (chunk of turf) when hitting a shot, make an effort to replace it. If it's not possible to replace it, please use the provided divot mix to repair the area.
